There was not a Board of Director's meeting in October due to Delegate Assembly. When Delegate Assembly is in session, it is the highest governing body of MAPE and the Board of Directors doesn't meet that month.

I did attend Delegate Assembly on Saturday, October 8, 2022 with several delegates from Local 2001. The Assembly was virtual, but Local 2001 delegates and alternates did meet at RCTC so we could caucus during the assembly.

DA did pass the 2023 Budget. The MAPE budget shows us that membership matters. During the Pandemic our membership did drop due to member leaders not being able to meet in person with new hires. Local 2001 is using some of our MAPE-tober time to reach out to those who are new in the last 3 or so years and invite them to be members.

DA did review 5 resolutions this year. Delegates from across the state debated the presented resolutions. The originally presented 5 resolutions can be found at

The resolution to make all MAPE documents accessible passed with some modifications put in place regarding timelines. The nomination committee resolution passed.
