Local Budget Motion Vote is needed for line-item change

4. ES and EC Series

- Kaity Taylor Recent salary range reassignment discussion
- As of July 31, Environmental Specialist and Environmental Consultant staff received a range bump in the compensation grid. New range minimum and maximums and level numbers available.
- This change does not result in an immediate increase in pay, unless:
- your current salary is below the minimum of new range
- you have been at the maximum of the previous step range for more than a year, then you are eligible for a delayed progression (the "oops sorry!") increase. There will not be back pay.
- If so, you should have gotten an additional wage notice from HR. Reach out to HR if you have not.

- Your anniversary date remains your anniversary date even if you are getting a bump now.
- Who initiated this change? HR and the Commissioner's Office were technically the initiators of this study to address inequities. Behind the scenes, MAPE's work on pushing for incentives for retention includes pay likely influenced the decision for the study.
- MAPE did not find out about the change ahead of the public release.
- MAPE intends to use this momentum to continue to address more inequities and wage adjustments.
- If interested in working toward these kinds of issues, consider applying to be a Region 3 Negotiation Representative.
- <u>HR FAQ on Lorax</u>, and an <u>MMB toolbox</u> on how they could potentially conduct any range reassignment.
