4. Commissioner and Governor Update

- Town hall from the Commissioner's Office on 5/1 still a lot of unknowns, but a few highlights:
 - MPCA is requesting an exemption for timing/start date just St. Paul, Duluth, Mankato and Rochester. More details to come.
 - ADA requests to be exempted should be submitted ASAP! Trainings will be provided on this.
- Governor's Office is not willing to rescind the RTO, and this makes negotiations all the more important! (see MAPE proposal 18 on Telework)
- Updates
- BWSR telework forms for BWSR were due yesterday we have multiple offices with space issues
- MNIT due to space, we are required to be in office 2 days a pay period, as of now. MNIT people, according to my sup, are *not* going to keep their assigned desks. I am currently assigned a desk and I am losing it.
- ADA requests need your physician to fill out a medical inquiry form which can take a while don't delay!
- St. Paul office workers got an extension but supervisors have to start the 50% time starting June 1st
- Katrina did confirm they will not be renting other office space. MPCA is waiting for MMB to approve their request to defer the implementation timeline due to space. MMB is supposed to let MPCA know this week about the extension request
- MPCA is purchasing software to be used to reserve work spaces It has been suggested to me that PCA and MNIT@PCA will be using Robin like the Stassen building

- The advice we are being given by business agents is to sign and then appeal if necessary but not signing means you don't have a telework agreement and would theoretically be required to be in office 100% of the time.

SEGIP Opening Proposal:

Single premiums per month

- 2025: \$41.84
- 2026 (if no change to cost sharing): \$48.87
- 2026 (Employer's proposal): \$127.05
- 160% increase

Family premiums per month

- 2025: \$285.42
- 2026 (no change): \$333.57
- 2026 (Employer's proposal): \$506.40
- 77% increase


