

ARTICLE XIII Complaint – MAPE Judicial Committee

As an active member in good standing of the Minnesota Association of Professional Employees (MAPE), I am filing a formal complaint for consideration by the Judicial Committee under Article XII and Article XIII §2(10).

Details of the Originating Offense

On August 1, 2024, at 4:15 pm, I was interviewed for the Field Director position by the first-round MAPE hiring committee, including Todd Maki, Suzanne Al-Kayali, Devin Bruce, and Vice President Angie Halseth. My interview also included a non-member of that committee, President Megan Dayton. While President Dayton clearly identified her role in the hiring process as taking effect during the second round of interviews, she nonetheless remained at the conference table through the duration of my interview. Her presence was distracting and, as the highest elected official in our union, came across as an attempt to influence the outcome of my interview. Vice President Halseth was the legitimate representative of the Executive Team at that juncture, and President Dayton was inappropriately interfering with Vice President Halseth's ability to discharge her official role fairly and effectively.
