

ARTICLE XIII Complaint – MAPE Judicial Committee

As an active member in good standing of the Minnesota Association of Professional Employees (MAPE), I am filing a formal complaint for consideration by the Judicial Committee under Article XII and Article XIII §2(10).

Details of the Originating Offense

On September 20, 2024, in a statement before the MAPE Board of Directors, President Dayton responded to my member comments from the previous board meeting on August 16, 2024. At one point during her 9/20/2024 comments, President Dayton asserted a failure on the part of Vice President Halseth to effectively conduct a fair hiring process as related to my first-round interview for the Field Director position on August 1, 2024. Vice President Halseth responded that she had attempted to apologize to me via phone call more than once and had left voicemails which, to date, had not been returned. Based on the records from both my work phone (as listed on the MAPE website) and my personal phone, I could not verify receiving any calls or voicemails from Vice President Halseth's number (651-717-6762, as listed on the MAPE website). Intentional untrue statements before the Board of Directors impedes the Regional Directors from fulfilling their lawful duties under Article VII, Section 2.
