

## Dear friends,

Thank you for being part of the journey to MAPE's 2019-2021 contract tentative agreement (TA). We did it. MAPE's bargaining team, made up of elected members, has been negotiating with the state for three months. Our proposals were built based on feedback from listening sessions we had with 2,500 members in 130 worksites, surveys and input forms. Our negotiations were rooted in your stories, hopes for the workplace and your involvement. The bargaining team fought to address the recruitment and retention crisis in the state workforce so that we continue to attract and retain a high-quality, professional workforce that can provide vital public services to all Minnesotans.

Highlights of the agreement include 2.25 percent and 2.5 percent across-the-board wage increase, step increases of 3.5 percent for eligible employees, student loan reimbursements, phased retirement and bereavement leave.

We will be hosting local contract information meetings all over the state to go through the agreement and answer any questions. I hope you can find the time to attend a meeting and gain insight into our negotiations journey and add your voice to the process.
