Business agent update (Dan Englehart)

- Becoming a Contract Action Team member is a great way to get involved, or get involved in electoral program, or other ways. Whether you have a title or just engage.
- Fire issues - still do not have pay for R&R for in-state and an issue related to time coding and overtime (trying to work on this through Meet & Confer and supplemental bargaining).

DNR Meet and Confer (Monica Weber)

- Met last week. Asked for clarification on time coding and other things related to leave, looking for more info for website so people know what to expect when going out on leave. Discussed telework provisions - report to work location is based on the position, not based on where you live (someone who was 30% in-office took a promotion and was told they needed to report 50%). We're asking management to be more clear on sharing info like that. If you hear of people with those questions - reach out to local leadership or a steward. Talked about boots, if your position requires you to work in multiple environments, we think agency should provide different types of PPE; FAW division disagrees (FOR and PAT have been more amenable).
