- Board of Directors met on June 23rd
 - Most of the meeting focused on the contract TA
 - Political Council is looking to create a new effort around civic engagement
 - Also announced that the 2024 Lobby Day will be Tuesday, March 19th
 - Audience for the civic engagement is likely
 - The BOD passed a resolution to temporarily freeze changes to local geographical structures to allow for assessment by year-end to address telework and agency consolidation

Contract Update/Negotiations Team Update, Kristin Kirchoff-Franklin Co-chair Negotiations committee

- Only members can vote on our contracts! Become a member by August 4th 11:59PM in order to vote.
- Brown bag discussions announcements will be coming out soon.
- Vote on Contract August 11th-17th
 - Full language should be out by the end of the week
 - o If contract passed, it goes into effect immediately, backpay until July 1st
 - Members will receive their backpay 4-6 weeks after contract ratified
 - Increase will go into effect either the first or second paycheck after we ratify
 - Healthcare effects do not go into effect until the next calendar year (1/1/2024)
 - The \$70 credit sunsets on 1/1/2025
 - One of their main priorities from MMB was to create incentive programs, they want to be able to authorize these programs
 - Currently the process is that they have to go through an MOU with MAPE
 - Now with the new language they have to give us notice when they create these programs.
 - If contract NOT passed, we're authorizing a strike and the negotiations starts over from scratch
 - If there is a tie, then is goes to Robert's rules and it would be voted down
