 - #meeting-agendas-minutes A file share to post our meeting agendas and minutes. Not for discussing them. (Council, staff, and President)
 - #politico-partners Where we have discussions with the organizing council (Council, staff, president, and outside partners such as the organizing council).
 #random
- Governing Documents/who we are/what we do: We received our governing documents (including the currently approved version of charter and bylaws).
